

Directions from North using 57

Head south on 57 continuing until you get to the Bradley/Kankakee area. Take exit 312 for Rt. 17 West. At the end of the ramp take a right at the stoplight. Follow Rt. 17 out of Kankakee and through the country for about 20 minutes. You will see a sign for Herscher on your right. You will be turning left. Take Herscher Road until you hit a stop sign. At the stop sign you will be turning right. Drive for two blocks and turn left onto Main Street (on the corner is a Shell/BP Station) **for the jazz competition**. The high school will be on your right hand side. Feel free to park in front of the first school building and enter the school through the red double doors.

For show choir parking stay on 115 past the Shell station. You will see the high school on your left and the parking lot. The main entrance is on the left side of the building when in the main parking lot. The entrance is a row of brown and glass doors.

Directions from North using 55

Head south on 55 continuing until you get to Exit 240 for Lorenzo Rd. Turn left on Lorenzo Rd. proceed 0.2 mile to the stop sign. Turn right onto the E. Frontage Rd. Follow Frontage Rd for 2.5 miles to IL-Rt 129, Turn left onto Rt. 129 South. Turn left at the first stop light in Braidwood. Go through the next light and follow the curve around. The next road on your right is Essex's Road (there is a sign marking the road). Turn Right on Essex's Road. Follow that through Essex's until you come to a "T" in the road. Turn left at that stop sign. Continue until you see a sign for Herscher on your right. Turn right on Herscher Road. Take Herscher Road until you hit a stop sign. At the stop sign you will be turning right (Rt.115). Drive for two blocks and turn left onto Main Street (on the corner is a Shell/BP Station) **for the jazz competition**. The high school will be on your right hand side. Feel free to park in front of the first school building and enter the school through the red double doors.

Drive for two blocks and turn left onto Main Street (on the corner is a Shell/BP Station) **for the jazz competition**. The high school will be on your right
